My name is Dr. Octavi Piulats. I am "Profesor Titular" in Philosophy and Culture at the Faculty of Philosophy of the Universitat de Barcelona, where I had the chance to meet Dr Albert Ferrer many years ago and get to know about his original academic work.

Dr Ferrer is one of the few scholars in our country to know in depth Eastern thought as well as Western. He spent around 10 years in India where he was a Visiting Professor in Sri Sathya Sai University; he has also visited some other Asian countries such as Myanmar (Burma), Malaysia and Singapore to pursue his comparative/intercultural research. He has been invited twice to the USA for academic purposes and, needless to say, he has developed an academic career in his own country and birth place, Barcelona.

Dr Ferrer has developed a teaching career in our Faculty of Philosophy, Universitat de Barcelona, for around ten years. He has given special courses and seminars and a number of lectures, always from his invaluable contribution to comparative philosophy and religion East/ West; in particular, he has taught about Indian and Buddhist philosophy, intercultural dialogue, history and philosophy of culture, etc. I must say that his teaching has not only been academically serious but also pedagogically enthralling, arising enthusiasm among our students who could stay asking questions for a long time.

In our own university, Universitat de Barcelona, Dr Ferrer made another significant contribution to the Master of Asian Studies, where he was the coordinator for Indian studies, and to the Master of History of Religions, where he was responsible for Buddhist studies; he was also in charge of Hindu studies in a similar academic setting at the Universitat Autonoma de Barcelona. He has been called several times by various departments of the Government of Catalonia for the training of civil servants in different areas such as international relations and intercultural/interreligious dialogue. Moreover, he has been appointed as Consultant for Education to the Government of Catalonia to bring his remarkable expertise on education.

Needless to say, Dr Ferrer still has a wider academic experience that you can follow through his outstanding resume. He is certainly a serious academician both in terms of research and teaching; I can only conclude that you can trust him as a scholar and lecturer.
