
The flaws of mainstream schooling

- Nurturing a valueless society
- The robotic pedagogy still prevailing in Asia
- Scientism/ technocracy prevailing in the West
- Most graduates unprepared for real life
- School failure inherent to the system
- Behavioural/ psychological troubles (esp. boys)
- Crisis of boys' education: boys left behind
- The different pedagogic needs of boys and girls not acknowledged
- Individual needs also neglected

The crisis of boys' education

- In all industrialized countries and now starting in Asia
- Three-quarters of students with behavioural problems
- Three-quarters of students with learning disabilities ARE BOYS
- Boys score lower than girls in normal/ special tests and public exams
- Boys earn as much as 80% of Ds and Fs
- Three-quarters of drop outs are boys
- Boys constitute only 40% of college students
- More boys smoke, drink, take drugs, commit suicide and acts of violence. One woman in jail for 15 males!
- Public and private reports claim new "recuperative masculinity politics" towards a recovery of boyhood while also caring for girls in a vision of harmony of the whole
